

CALCULUS REMOVAL CHART INSTRUCTIONS

Only graded calculus assessments import into the calculus removal chart. The import occurs when the instructor saves a new grade header then clicks on **REMOVAL CHART** in the header. If the Removal Chart button has an asterisk (*) on it that means there is either not an assessment chart prepared or no graded visit exist on the chart and no findings will be imported for this appointment. Click on **ASSESSMENT first** and grade them before clicking on **REMOVAL CHART**. If you open the removal chart BEFORE you **grade** the assessment there will be nothing in the calculus removal chart. Click **outer** circles where supra calculus remains and **inner** circles where sub calculus remains. An **x** will appear.

Example. Student marks visit 1 findings into the assessment chart. Instructor creates a header for the appointment and clicks on **ASSESSMENT CHART** to grade the student on the assessment. No debridement is done at this appt so no removal chart is created. Student adds a second visit to assessment chart and marks findings. Client comes back for debridement appt. Instructor creates a new header and clicks on **Assessment Chart** to make sure assessment visits are graded and saved. Then click on **Removal Chart**. The software will import all the graded visits with findings of calculus from the assessment chart. If the client needs a third visit to finish debridement repeat process. Use the **CLEAR** check box on the removal chart to remove any imported findings that have already been graded in a previous visit.

Figure 1. Assessment chart created by the student. Notice the instructor has not yet graded visit 2 so visit 2 findings will not be imported into the removal chart.

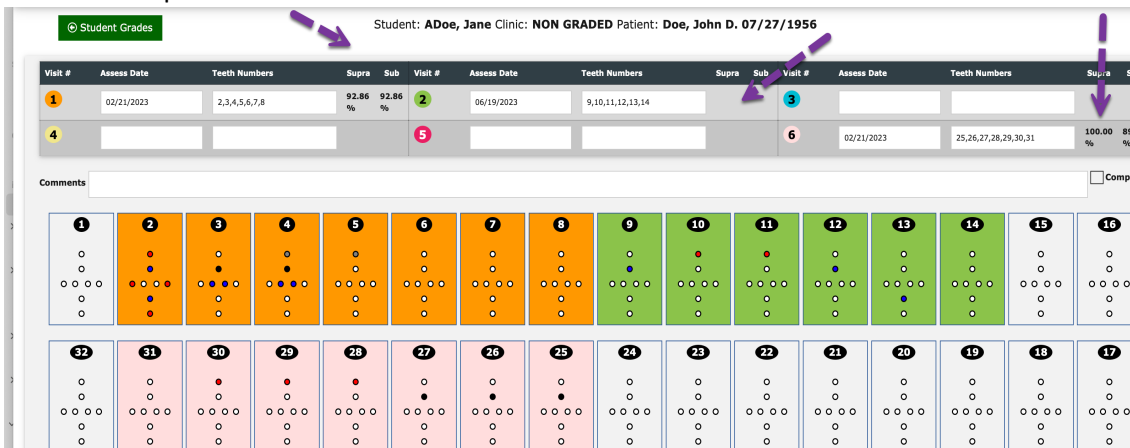


Figure 2. Removal chart imported graded findings of calculus. Visit 1 imported only teeth 2,3,4. Teeth 6-8 had no calculus and tooth 5 the instructor marked no calculus existed. Visit 2 has not been graded so no findings are imported. Visit 6 has been graded. Teeth 25-30 have calculus and were imported. If any imported teeth are not debrided during this appointment then clear them from the chart by clicking the **CLEAR** box. If you need to add additional assessments go **BACK TO ASSESSMENT** and add additional assessment findings for teeth not imported to the removal chart.
