

TalEval can now calculate the weight of the TalEval grade for you.

If TalEval does not count as 100% of the student's clinic grade you may want TalEval to calculate the weighted grade for you. We added a new field on the Student Grade Report form labeled "Weight". It defaults to 75%, the most commonly used weight schools apply to the TalEval grade. If you want TalEval to count as 100% of the clinic grade leave the weight field blank or enter 100% or just use the final grade as before.

The weighted grade appears on the Ind. Student Grade Report in a new column labeled **WEIGHTED**. See **Figure 1** below. If you print the grade report for 1 clinic the calculation for the "Weighted" grade is: **Final * Weight**. Using the example below, the calculation for the first student on the report is $83.80 * 75\% = 62.85$ (final grade * weight). If you print the Grade Report for multiple clinics the calculation uses the AVERAGE * the weight.
